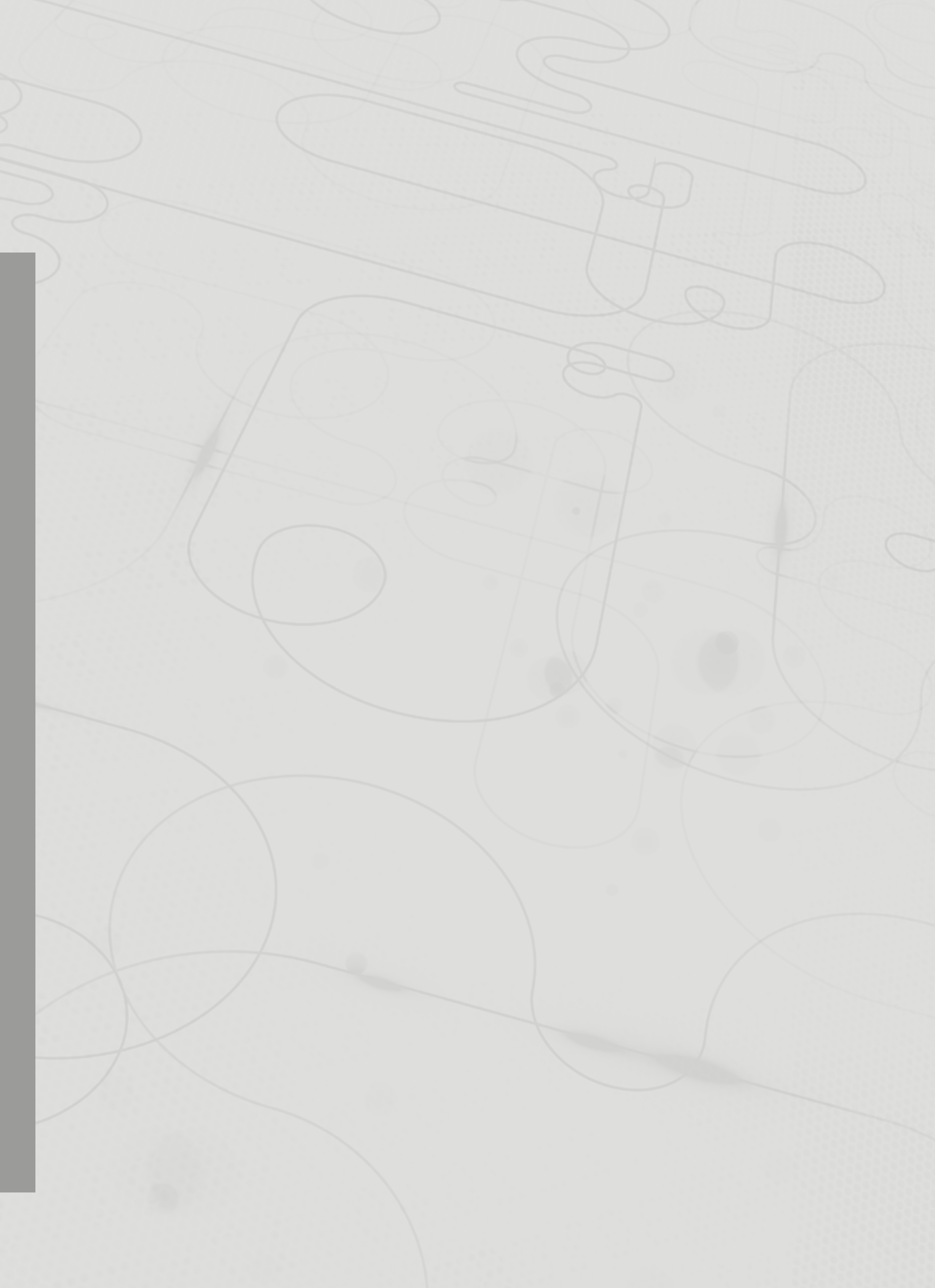

ANU E Press was launched in 2004 to explore the options offered by emerging e-publishing technology for the University's academic output. At the beginning of 2014, ANU E Press became ANU Press and, as of January 2016, our small, committed team has published over 640 titles as ebooks and Print-on-Demand (PoD) books.

Electronic publishing has lots of advantages over traditional publishing methods: it's inexpensive and rapid, which is particularly valuable in the dissemination of new research and academic exploration. Lowered production costs reduce the pressure to recoup expenses through profits, which allows ANU Press to:

- > give voice to researchers whose work is excellent but may lack a significant commercial audience
- > demolish barriers to entry for developing fields of research that might struggle against traditional, risk-averse publication models
- > publish texts that deal with contemporary issues and breaking research at the height of relevance and public interest
- > maximise the clarity and impact of research data by using meaningful photos, images and graphs without increasing the cost of production.

ANU Press produces fully peer-reviewed research publications and is recognised by the Department of Education and Training as a commercial publisher, so authors who publish through ANU Press gain full recognition under the Higher Education Research Data Collection scheme. As ANU generates more and more original research, ANU Press fulfils the vital role of distributing that research through stylish, well-designed and accessible electronic/PoD texts.

Electronic publishing also has incredible advantages for readers. Ebooks:

- > allow wide dissemination of information at very low cost—a student or researcher can either download or read online any of ANU Press's texts immediately, from anywhere in the world
- > make searching text easy, a huge benefit for researchers and students mining diverse tomes for specific information
- > are environmentally advantageous—a lower need for printing means a lower demand for paper, and electronic formats don't incur the carbon impact of shipping and distribution as do traditional hard copy formats.

## Information for authors

A comprehensive explanation of ANU Press publishing processes is available on our website ([press.anu.edu.au/information-for-authors](http://press.anu.edu.au/information-for-authors)), but here's a brief overview.

ANU Press refers all proposals to the relevant editorial committee for evaluation. Once the committee is satisfied a manuscript is suitable for publication, they'll arrange peer review (a minimum of two double-blind reports, with at least one sourced from outside ANU). Manuscripts then need to be professionally copyedited and styled before production can begin.

Depending on the manuscript, production takes about three months. At the end of the process, the book is published on the ANU Press website and is available to read online, download as an ebook free of charge or purchase as a PoD. We also register your book in a range of databases to make sure it is distributed as widely as possible.

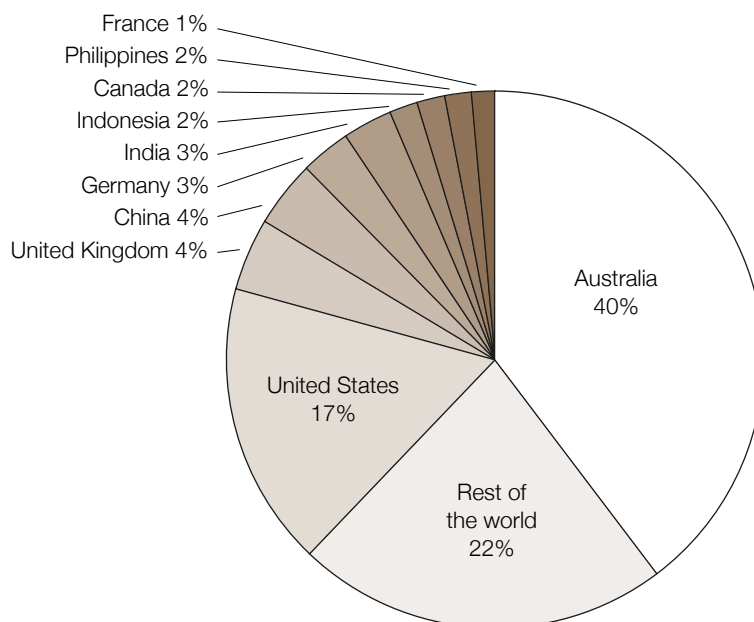

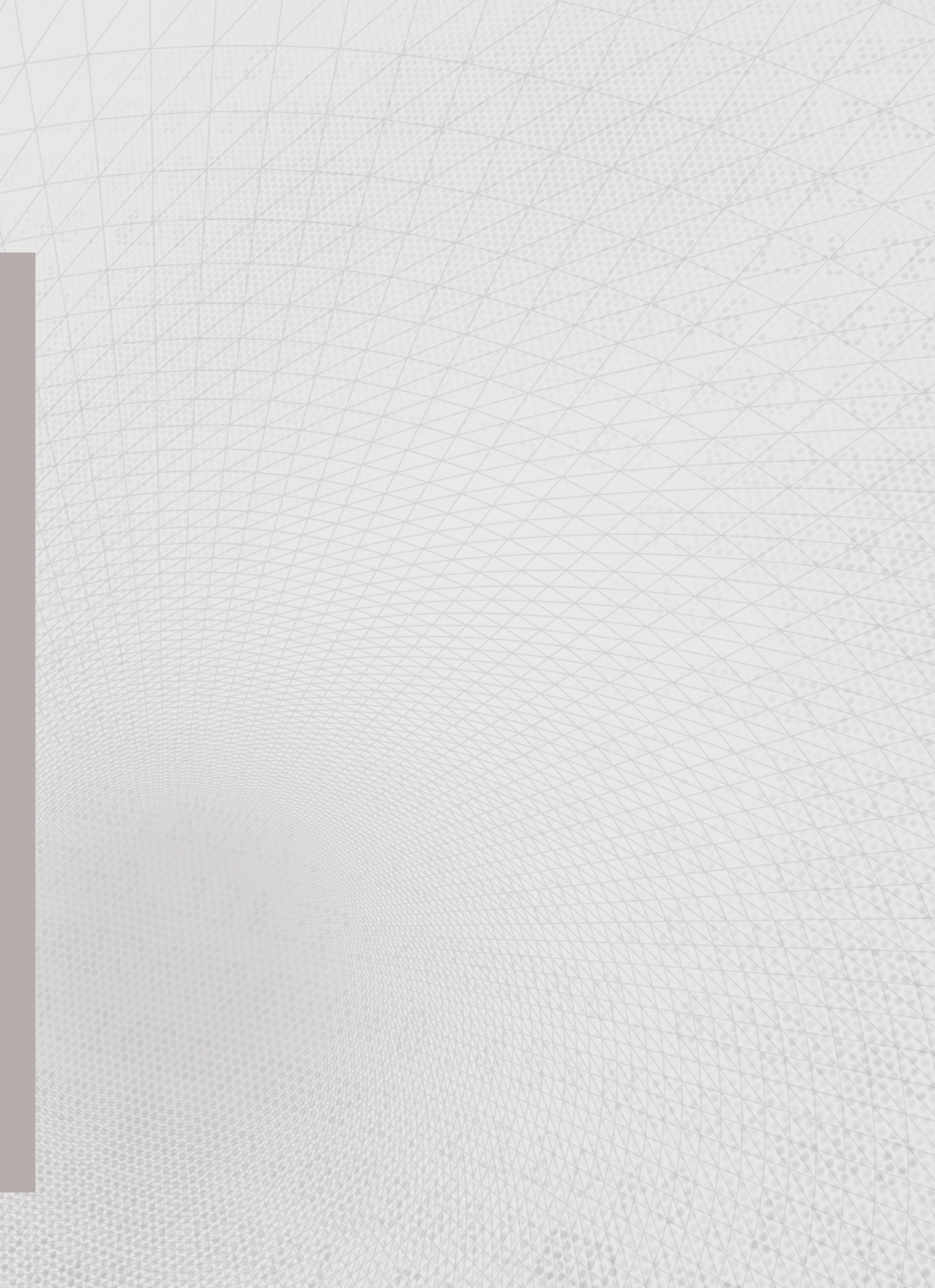

## Where in the world are ANU Press readers?

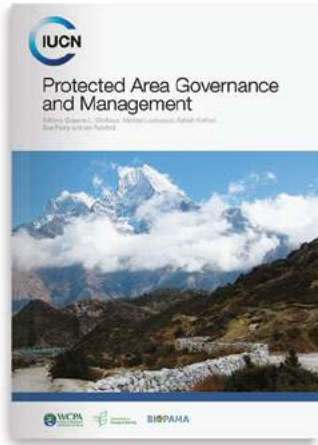

The second is to position contemporary public health issues in an interdisciplinary context and in ways that highlight the interdependency between the environment, human institutions and behaviours; a broad approach championed by Tony. The third is to encourage emerging and future public health leaders to advocate for policies and cultural change to sustain and improve human health, from a foundation of objective scholarship.

*The book's foreword and 38 chapters were written by people who were inspired by Tony; many of whom worked with him at some point in the last 40 years. Its structure reflects five major public health domains, each of which Tony made major contributions to in an extremely productive academic life: occupational health and safety; environmental and social epidemiology; nutrition and food systems; climate change and health; and ecosystem change and infectious disease. The final section, 'Transformation', is dedicated to Tony's desire for public health scientists to propose adaptive and mitigating solutions to the problems they were observing.*

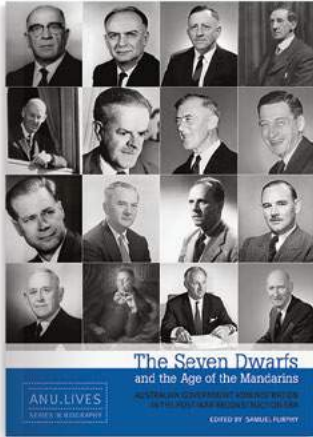

The vast shape-shifting continent of Australia enables us to take a long view of history. We consider ways to cross the great divide between the deep past and the present. Australia's human past is not a short past, so we need to enlarge the scale and scope of history beyond 1788. In ways not so distant, these deeper times happened in the same places where we walk today. Yet, they were not the same places, having different surfaces, ecologies and peoples. Contributors to this volume show how the earth and its past peoples can wake us up to a sense of place as history—as a site of both change and continuity.

*Long History, Deep Time ignites the possibilities of what the spaces and expanses of history might be. 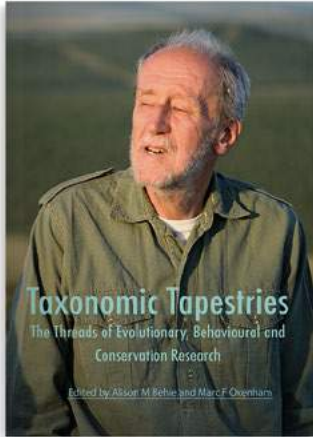

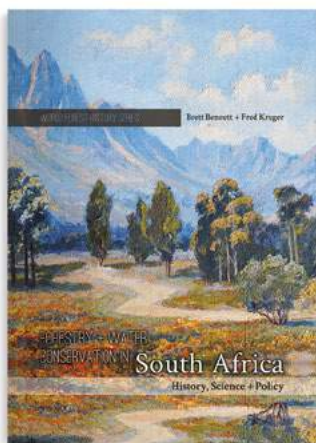

This innovative interdisciplinary study focuses on the history, science and policy of tree planting and water conservation in South Africa. South Africa's forestry sector has sat—often controversially—at the crossroads of policy and scientific debates regarding water conservation, economic development, and biodiversity protection. Bennett and Kruger show how debates about the hydrological impact of exotic tree planting in South Africa shaped the development of modern scientific ideas and state policies relating to timber plantations, water conservation, invasive species control, and biodiversity management within South Africa as well as elsewhere in the world. *Forestry and Water Conservation in South Africa* shows how scientific research on the impact of exotic and native vegetation led to the development of a comprehensive national policy for conserving water, producing timber, and protecting indigenous species from invasive alien plants. Policies and laws relating to forests and water began to change in the late 1980s and early 1990s as a result of political and administrative changes within South Africa. This book suggests that the country's contemporary policies towards timber plantations, guided by the *National Water Act* of 1998, need to be reconsidered in light of the authors' findings. Bennett and Kruger also call for more interdisciplinary research and greater emphasis on integrated policies and management plans for forestry, invasive alien plants, water conservation, and biodiversity preservation.

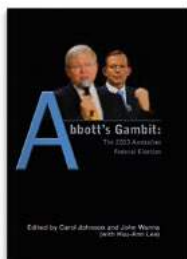
